## The Magic of Music

Smiley faces. Tapping feet. Angelic voices. Joyful hearts.

That's the power of music, and that's what happened during the Music Therapy session at Biorn Club House on May 18.

The magic started when the kids got to make their own musical instruments before singing — and that changed everything!

As the kids pulled out the recycled materials they had brought from home, the excitement in the room was hard to miss.





## **Making Instruments**

With their parents by their side, the children began creating their own shakers. Some used cardboard tubes, others had plastic bottles — all filled with dried beans and sealed with colorful tape.

Little hands worked with care, focus, and joy. In just a short time, each child held a musical instrument they had made all by themselves. And the pride on their faces? Simply priceless.

Then it was time to sing!

Led by Ms Ivy Tan, founder of Life Tunes Music Therapy, the children — with instruments in hand and smiles on their faces — sang “You Are My Sunshine”, and the room lit up!

It wasn't just the melody or the rhythm. It was the energy, the freedom, and the pure happiness that filled the space.

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## Singing From Their Hearts

The children's joy was contagious, but the most heartwarming moment was still to come.

To everyone's surprise, Ms. Ivy gently invited the children to compose their own songs — yes, their very own!

One by one, each child stood up and sang their personal song to their family, using the instruments they had just made.

No fancy stage, no microphones — just honest, beautiful music from the heart.

Parents smiled through teary eyes. Some held their hands over their hearts. These were the kind of moments that stay with you forever.

A big thank you to Ms. Ivy for bringing such a meaningful and creative experience to the children!

## **A Powerful Performance**

Next came the powerful finale: a stirring cello performance by Mr. Tan Shang Wy, a talented cellist with autism.

At two years old, Shang Wy was drawn to symphony orchestras, especially the string instruments. At six, he learned music theory. By nine, he began playing the cello — and it became his voice.

Though he lives with autism, Shang Wy shone through his music, reminding us that people with special needs have gifts, voices and dreams that can bless the world.

As we headed to Warung Kita for lunch, families sat together, sharing laughs and bonding over stories. This session wasn't just about music. It was about joy, creativity, courage, and love.

**It was a reminder that every child — with their own rhythm, voice, and spirit — can shine. And they truly did.**

# Soft Opening of Biorn Club House: A New Beginning!



We're so happy to share that the renovation of Biorn Club House is now complete!

On May 14, we celebrated this special milestone with a soft opening — a small but meaningful gathering filled with warmth, joy, and hope.

We invited family and friends to join us. The celebration began with a light morning tea. After that, we shared the story of how Biorn Club came to life — a journey that began not with big plans, but with a simple, heartfelt desire: to build a loving and inclusive community for families with children with special needs.



## The Biorn Club Story: Our Journey so far

**In the beginning, our resources were limited.**

But with faith and courage, we launched our first monthly event on the second Sunday of January 2025.

Just five families joined us that day, and the event lasted only an hour and a half.

But something special happened that day: The joy on the children's faces and the encouraging words from parents told us that **we were on the right path.**

From that day on, we continued holding monthly events, always with the same goal in mind:

To bring joy, strengthen families, and build a safe, caring space where everyone feels they belong.

A space where parents feel heard, where children feel free, and where families don't have to walk this journey alone.

**As we kept going, we began to see a deeper need:** we needed a place to call home.

Not just to avoid hall rental fees, but to create a space that could grow with us — a place for daily programs, where children could learn, play, and discover their unique gifts.

We began to see how, over time, transformation happens. Not only in the children, but in all of us.

When a child laughs freely...

When a parent feels truly understood...

When families connect without fear or shame...

— **something begins to shift.**
